This agreement was subsequently extended to cover Japan.

Plantic is now pleased to announce that its material is being used by DuPont to package BPA free baby bottles for the latest Weil Baby (™) product line. The inserts for these bottles are fully compostable and dissolve in water, thereby increasing their environmental credentials. The products can be purchased on line and through the Babys-R-Us chain.
